Goals

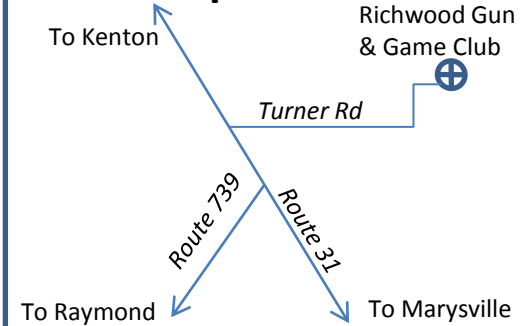
- Students will prepare for competition in a sanctioned Civilian Marksmanship Program Rimfire Sporter Match.
